Easy Payment Options

Paying your HOA dues has never been so easy! St. Augustine Shores Service Corporation offers several convenient options to pay your monthly HOA dues. The preferred method of payment for the association is ACH bank withdrawal.

ACH stands for Automated Clearing House which allows homeowners to electronically send money from your bank account directly to a company to pay your bill. Residents can fill out an ACH form in our office and attach a voided check. Our staff will enter this information into our system and on the first of every month, your HOA dues are automatically drafted from your bank account electronically. There is no fee to sign up for this option and it helps keep your account current and paid on time.

There are other options to pay your HOA bill also including: cash, check, online payment through our website, and credit card.

Heading into 2025, if you are currently on ACH bank withdrawal, the association has a new form that must be completed before the next billing cycle.

Stovetop Corned Beef & Cabbage

INGREDIENTS

- Corned beef brisket: Look for a ready-to-cook corned beef brisket, preferably flat cut.
- Cabbage: You can use standard green cabbage or <u>Savoy cabbage</u>.
- Potatoes: We recommend baby or small Yukon Gold or <u>red</u>
 <u>potatoes</u>. Avoid starchy potatoes like Russet, which may fall apart
 during cooking.
- Carrots: About 5 to 6 medium carrots.
- **Beer**: Use a bottle or can of <u>lager or brown ale</u> for a full-flavored broth. If you prefer, you can use low-sodium beef broth instead of beer.


